

JOB SUMMARY

Under the general supervision of the Public Services Director, the Deputy Director plays a key role in planning, organizing, and overseeing departmental activities, including capital improvement project management. The position supports or serves in place of the Director when necessary and provides expertise in areas such as engineering, infrastructure planning, stormwater management, water treatment, sewage collection, roadway improvements, and landscape maintenance.

Responsibilities include reviewing site plans, plats, and permits for compliance with City codes, offering guidance to design professionals, preparing staff reports, and collaborating with local, state, and federal agencies, such as Broward County, FDOT, and SFWMD. The role also addresses unique engineering and construction challenges, contributing to the execution of the City's infrastructure and development goals. This is an excellent opportunity to advance your career and make a meaningful impact on the City's growth.

JOB DESCRIPTION

- Review site plans, plats, and building permits for compliance with drainage, paving and grading, water, and sewer requirements.
- Supervise the work of division supervisory staff and work teams; assign work activities, projects, and programs; monitor work flow, schedule, and budget; coaches, motivate, monitor, correct, and evaluate performance; develop and implement staff training programs and plans, particularly in employee safety; recommend employee recognition, discipline, and termination
- Oversee, participate, and manage the development of Capital Improvement Program budgets; participate in the forecast of expenses and additional funds needed for staffing, consultants, equipment, materials, and supplies; administer the approved budget and capital improvements program.

- Draft memorandum, letters, and other forms of correspondence; prepare various reports, presentations; and report/present findings to Public Services Director, City Manager, City Commission, Committees, Developers, and members of the community.
- Respond to and meet with property owners, homeowner groups, business districts, and the public; meet and negotiate with various regulatory agencies; represent the City as a witness in legal actions.
- Manage special programs and coordinate engineering assistance to other departments.
- Participate in City Commission meetings and other community meetings, as required.
- Perform related duties as directed when such duties are a logical and appropriate assignment to the position.

Dania Beach operates under a commission-city manager form of government and provides services its residents. The city manager is the chief executive officer and is responsible for executing the policies and programs adopted by the City Commission.

The projected Fiscal Year 2024 General Fund Budget is \$74,083,256. The City has approximately 200 team members.

The city's population is approximately 32,000 with a median household income of \$47,135 and about 16,000 housing units.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering or a closely related field.
- Minimum of six (6) years of increasingly responsible municipal engineering experience.
- Minimum two (2) years of supervisory experience along with substantial experience in managing public works capital improvement programs, transportation engineering, and development planning.
- Must hold a current State of Florida Professional Engineering (PE) license.
- Possession of a valid driver's license with an overall good driving record is required. If the driver's license is out of state, must be able to obtain a Florida driver's license within thirty (30) days of the hire date.

DESIRED REQUIREMENTS

- Eight (8) to ten (10) years of increasingly responsible municipal engineering experience.
- Four (4) to six (6) years of supervisory experience along with substantial experience in managing public works capital improvement programs, transportation engineering, and development planning.
